### Summary

Dr Krusz has an undergraduate degree in pharmacy (B.S.) and was a Registered Pharmacist (R. Ph.), practicing in this field part-time, until the end of his medical studies. Following undergraduate training, he completed graduate studies in neuropharmacology (Ph.D.). He then completed a 2-year post-doctoral research fellowship in geriatric neuropharmacology, receiving several academic and teaching appointments, together with consulting activity in advertising, as he completed his medical studies (MD), with specialized training in neurology.

Since 1987, Dr Krusz has been in private practice in Dallas with major clinical interests in the evaluation and treatment of pain and headache disorders, and with a special focus in the field of brain injury, and neuropsychiatry/neurobehavioral disorders. He is the medical director of Anodyne Headache and PainCare, a multidisciplinary clinic in North Dallas. He has been actively engaged in clinical research projects, particularly in new uses for available medications for headache, pain, cognitive enhancement and mood. He is active in numerous organizations and, most recently was elected Vice-President of the American Board of Electroencephalography and Neurophysiology (ABEN). This organization administers specialized board exams in the field of EEG. Most recently, he has been appointed to the Board of directors of the Texas Pain Society. Dr Krusz has a strong interest in the evaluation of brain disorders using EEG and other techniques such as neuropsychological cognitive testing, combined with PET/SPECT scan techniques. He is also very interested in aggressive IV treatment of pain and headache flare-ups in the outpatient clinic setting, and has developed protocols for such treatment using new IV formulations of existing oral medications. Additional interests include novel administration technique for treating patients with botulinum toxins.
